

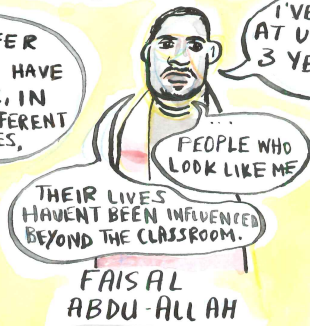

ONE PROGRAM IS THE ARTIST IN RESIDENCE

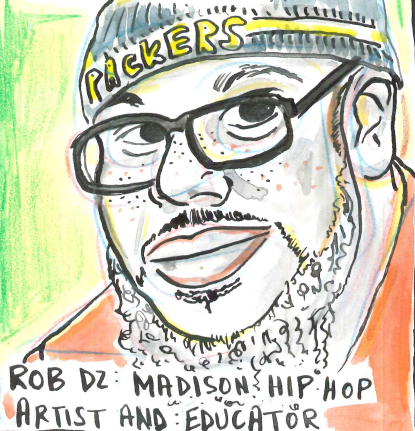
